

April 9, 2019 Minutes

The Coffee County Legislative Body met April 9, 2019 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Sheriff Chad Partin proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Pastor Jim Norman from Highland Baptist Church in Tullahoma gave the Invocation and Todd Crockett led the Pledge to the Flag.

There were 20 members present for the meeting with Helen DeBellis being absent.

Duncan made the motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Ray. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Kraft and seconded by Duncan to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Kraft to approve the following notaries as listed: Bridget Anderson, Cindy B. Anderson, Dana E. Baker, Thomas W. Darnell, Jr., Catherine E. Farrar, Judith Gawrys, Steven K. Gilbert, Stephanie Haley, April D. Hansert, Ben Scott Leeder, Regina A. McKeown, Zella C. Mullins, Laura W. Noe, Scott Peterson, Kayla Sanderfur, Pamela A. Thompson, Gabriela West and Judy Winton. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Mayor Cordell placed Claude Morse in nomination to the Public Building Authority. Motion made by Sebourn and seconded by Deford to approve Claude Morse to the PBA. The motion was approved with 15 yes votes, 4 no votes and 1 abstained. The no votes were Hollandsworth, Hobbs, Cunningham and Crabtree and Hunt abstained.

Motion made by Tildon Stubblefield and seconded by Ray for the adoption of Resolution 2019-05 of the County of Coffee to be a complete count county and partner with the United States Census Bureau to carry out the mandate in the Constitution of the United States, Article 1, Section II, for the 2020 Decennial Census, thereby fostering an environment of participation of its residents to

maximize a complete and accurate count of its population during the 2020 Decennial Census. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Miller and seconded by Orrick for the adoption of Resolution 2019-06 authorizing the Issuance of Rural School Refunding Bonds of Coffee County, Tennessee, in the approximate aggregate principal amount of Seventeen Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$17,400,000) for the purpose of refinancing all or a portion of certain outstanding obligations of the County; making provision for the issuance, sale and payment of said bonds; Establishing the terms thereof and the disposition of proceeds therefrom; and providing for the Levy of Taxes for the payment of principal of, premium, if any, and interest on the bonds. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Tim Stubblefield and seconded by Kraft for the adoption of Resolution 2019-07 authorizing submission for a litter and trash collection grant from the Tennessee Department of Transportation and authorizing the acceptance of said grant. The motion was approve with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Cunningham and seconded by Crabtree for the adoption of Resolution 2019-08 specifying the residential location of members appointed to the Public Building Authority. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes. Hollandsworth and Hobbs voted no.

Motion made by Kraft and seconded by Cunningham to approve the proposed funding request to support the \$500,000 match between Coffee, Warren and White counties for the Tri County Railroad. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Sebourn and seconded by Duncan for the adoption of Resolution 2019-09 Resolution Amending Resolution #2017-32, which adopted certain of the 2012 Edition Building Codes to revert to the 2009 Edition concerning the International Energy Conservation Code. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.
