New Business: The Sheriff talked about the following:

-- The population stats – (attached are the reports)

---The units for the jail are 17 weeks out, the jail is the same as the rest of the building. If the inmates are hot, we are hot as well and if they are cold, we are cold as well.

--The camera system for the jail bidding has opened, and we are looking at the highs 200K.

--We have had a few pursuits, and some vehicles have been hit, but we needed to get these people off the road and in the jail where they belong. Sheriff said he may be looking at getting heavier steel push bumpers for the vehicles.

--The valves on the water flow back in the jail that Trane put on are not lasting and when these are going out, we are replacing with the old valves that were on there, we need a high flow.
