The Coffee County Legislative Body met June 13, 2023 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

There were 16 members present for the meeting with Joey Hobbs and Tim Morris being absent.

Motion made by Hershman and seconded by Duncan to approve the agenda. The motion was approved with 16 yes votes.

Motion made by Hershman and seconded by Deford to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 15 yes votes and Hunt abstained.

Motion made by Sebourn and seconded by Jones to approve the proclamations, items 8 a-f with one vote. The motion was approved by voice vote.

Motion made by Stubblefield and seconded by Reed to approve the following items 8 a-f: A proclamation commemorating May 25th as "Mrs. Opal Casey Day". Motion made by Stubblefield and seconded by Hershman to approve #171-2023-19 Rural Capital Projects Fund. The motion was approved with 16 yes votes.

Motion made by Deford and seconded by Reed to approve #131-2023-20 Highway Public Works Fund. The motion was approved with 16 yes votes.

Motion made by Nettles and seconded by Stubblefield to approve #118-2023-21 Ambulance Service Fund. The motion was approved with 16 yes votes.
