

July 12, 2022 Minutes

The Coffee County Legislative Body met July 12, 2022 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Corporal Davis proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Mark Barron from the Cumberland Presbyterian Church gave the Invocation and David Orrick led the Pledge to the Flag.

There were 20 members present for the meeting with Roseanne Smith being absent.

Mayor Cordell requested to approve the agenda. Motion made by Ray and seconded by Duncan to approve the agenda. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Ray and seconded by Orrick to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Duncan and seconded by Sebourn to approve the following notaries as listed: Rachel Ann Nicole Addison, Madison Lee Alvarado, Janet K. Armstrong, Noah C. Bean, Mary Grace Bernabe Berro, Nasharia L. Brown, Cindy Darlene Callender, Julie Crabtree, Forrest Micajon Dykes, Kezley Gipson, Melissa Dawn House, Katie Lightfoot, Bett Sue McAfee, Katrina Zimmerman Pearl and Rachel Ross. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.


Motion made by Hunt and seconded by Orrick for the adoption of Resolution 2022-28 authorizing the County Purchasing Agent to proceed with the sale of the real estate generally known as the Museum Property. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Kraft and seconded by Orrick to approve the proposal to use \$500,000 ARP funds as seed money for a new Animal Control Building with the stipulation that construction of the building begin within 18 months. Motion made by Morse and seconded by Debellis to postpone until the September. The motion

failed with 15 no votes, 4 yes votes and 1 abstained. Debellis, Morse, Hobbs and Taylor voted yes. No votes were Hollandsworth, Bryan, Cunningham, Keele, Orrick, Kraft, Ray, Deford, Miller, Tim Stubblefield, Tildon Stubblefield, Poston, Duncan, Crabtree and Sebourn. Hunt abstained. The motion to approve was approved with 16 yes votes. Morse and Taylor voted no and Tildon Stubblefield abstained.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
